<b>Section A</b> <b>Community Overview</b>
<b>A.1 Briefly describe the community and its historical development</b> Andisheh city is a triangular-shaped city with the area of 1495 Hectares that is located at west of Tehran, three kilometers northwest of Shahryar county, and 7 kilometers southeast of Karaj city; due to its specific location, it has a suitable access to transportation networks. Its altitude is 1200 meters above the sea level and it has a hot and dry climate; it is a windy city with respect to its location in Shahryar County.

It must be a higher level of safety than average for a community in the country or region.</b> Safe community Steering committee of Andisheh city has decided to prevent intentional and unintentional injuries, and is required to execute effective projects by involving public and private organizations and change the city to a safe place for living, education, working, and leisure activities; accordingly, the following objectives are accomplished: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Increasing the Citizens participation in planning and execution of safe community projects</li><li>2. Calling regional managers attention to the safety promotion and injury prevention</li><li>3. Improving inter-sector coordination and collaboration in order to involve them in the environmental safety promotion</li><li>4. Defining safety priorities in Andisheh city</li><li>5. To develop an injuries registration system in Andisheh City</li><li>6. To prevent injuries due to interpersonal violence in Andisheh City</li></ol>

<b>A.4 Describe the injury risk-panorama in the community.</b> According to the statistical reviews in previous years and type and location of the damages , the steering committee held meetings; finally, four following workgroups were appointed to formally initiate concerning activities: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Workgroup of the traffic and roads network accidents</li><li>2) Workgroup of the children and playground safety</li><li>3) Workgroup of high-risk behaviors (Suicide and addiction) prevention</li><li>4) Workgroup of safe home, workplace, and construction sites (Silent deaths, adults fall off)</li></ol>

**Structure of the community**

**B.1 Describe the demographic structure of the community**

More than 120,000 people are resided in the city, 62188 male and 57812 female ; 106128 people are educated but 13872 people are illiterate (less than 7 years old children are included), 115170 people are employed , (students and housewives are deemed to be occupied too) and 4830 people are jobless; people younger than 18 years old are considered as children based on United nations treaty definition; thus, there are 29792 children in Andisheh city , namely 25 percent of the population are children.

**B.2 Describe the SC/IP at present and the plans for the future.**

As a result of immigration, the rate of social hazards is relatively high in Shahryar county; although the rate is significantly lower in Andisheh city, this city is not an exception to such hazard so in the different work groups, representative from governmental and nongovernmental organizations are planning short term and long term program for prompting safety in Andisheh city.

**B.3 Describe the support for sustained injury prevention of the local politicians in the community and which parts of the program have been undertaken and/or supported by the regional government?**

Most of decisions for injury prevention are taken by the regional government

**B.4 Describe the strategic program concerning the safety promotion and injury prevention work, which has been formulated!**

In the traffic and roads network accidents workgroup the strategic programs are: Training and communication, Providing Information, Determining high-risk places for safety promotion and Safety promotion of public transportation. The strategic programs of high-risk behaviors (Suicide and addiction) prevention workgroup are: Training and providing information, Empowerment, Individual trainings, Supportive measures and Providing consultation. The strategic programs of Programs of safe home workplace, and construction sites (Silent deaths, adults fall off) workgroup are: Training household wives in order to reducing children's injury and fall off in home and training construction workers.

The mayor of Andisheh city is responsible for the management of SP/IP programs

Safe community steering committee

It is a sustained program

Yes, they cover the whole community such as children, elderly, woman, workers and young people.

Specialized Representatives from governmental and nongovernmental organizations in different workgroups

Safe community is evaluated through a checklist in different stages, also field survey, minutes and questionnaires are utilized as evaluation tools of the safe community. All actions are monitored every six months; the corrective action is taken place. The results are reported to the chairman of the safe community steering committee of Andisheh City.

<p><b>1.2 Describe how the local government and the health sector are collaborating in the SC/IP work.</b>  Some representatives from local government and the health sector take part in different meeting of safe community work groups and present statistic of different injuries according to their organization's field study.</p>

## **Safe traffic**

To construct simple and mechanized pedestrian bridges for the safe passage

- Ø To formulate a comprehensive traffic plan for Andisheh citizens' safety
- Ø To install ramps on public places for disables safe passage
- Ø To remove impeding electricity posts to more suitable places
- Ø Existence of an open channel in Fardis at entrance of Phase 2 which exit at the Phase 4 to Chitgar road was safety problem in recent years; children and vehicles fell into the channel and its septic exit. Thus, concerned workgroup asked the sewage department of Karaj city to temporarily fence the channel passage.
- Ø The workgroup identified high-risk traffic sites in the city; hence, some speed reducers were installed wherever needed; they were also painted.
- Ø Parks and roads needed some lights; for more details there are some descriptions below.
- Ø Light pedestals of parks were purchased and installed
- Ø The roads were leveled to facilitate more traffic for disables and blind citizens
- Ø Training safe traffic behavior to children
- Ø Safe traffic brochures were distributed in schools
- Ø CCTVs was installed in the city by municipality for traffic control
- Ø High-risk traffic areas were identified and authorities were notified
- Ø Pedestrian lineation accomplished
- Ø 140 billion riyal credit was assigned for widening Jafargholikhani Road. In order to reduce heavy traffic and to prevent longtime accidents, authorities of municipality signed a contract with owners of the nearby residential homes; the road is completely safe now.
- Ø New traffic signs were purchased and installed; in addition, pedestrian pavement accomplished.
- Ø High-risk areas were geometrically repaired

## **Safe homes and leisure times**

The safety certification was issued to the buildings which were to achieve construction completion certification; in addition, issuing safety certification was considered for previously built buildings.

- Ø First, meeting to assess the procedure of issuing certification, evaluations during construction, and issuing certification of completion was held by attendance of the chairman of engineering council of Andisheh city, representatives of the construction corporation, the construction corporation of Andisheh city, and the principle members of the workgroup and new guidelines were added to the previous protocols. According to these changings, execution of national regulations for construction became mandatory for all the landlords in order to achieve the construction completion certification. At the time of evaluation, all the safety measures including windows guards, gas pipe laying, distance between bars in railings, smokestacks shape and position, elevators, and etc. must be evaluated; evaluation by the fire department safety experts is another obligation that must be considered by the landlords before achieving the certification.
- Ø In order to prevent silent deaths due to CO, the prevention program was followed by visiting every house for appropriate smokestacks; as a result, the mortality rate due to CO had a decrease of 80% in the year 2010 in contrast to previous year.
- Ø Holding the earthquake preparedness maneuver and training families about how to react and protect themselves at the time of earthquake
- Ø Another success of this workgroup was safety training to the housewives. In this program, 3000 women were trained periodically for preventing domestic hazards

### **Safe children**

Two sport complexes, named Velayat and Isar, were constructed and opened in 2011. The Velayat sport complex is constructed in a land with the area of 8546 m<sup>2</sup> and the infrastructure of 4500 m<sup>2</sup> and is comprised of swimming pool, Sauna, Jacuzzi, multipurpose saloon, and martial arts. Isar sport complex is constructed in an area of 7458 m<sup>2</sup> with infrastructure of 3300 m<sup>2</sup> and has a multipurpose saloon.

In addition, construction of several parks and gardens was planned; these gardens are suitable for socializing and propagation of cultural and religious ideas and matter.  
In addition, all of the parks are equipped with the following devices and facilities purchased in order to attract and welcome people

- fitness devices
- Alcoves
- Benches
- Trash bins
- Drinking fountain

- Installation and improvement of equipment in play areas for children

### **Safe work**

Ø Holding workshop for business owners, construction workers, service and green area workers became one of the major activities of the safe community Secretariate

Ø Beside celebrating the Labor day, safety promotion measures were introduced to the labors

Ø Wearing helmet became mandatory for all the construction workers; it is controlled and supervised by supervision officers as well as engineering council of Andisheh city

Ø All labors who worked in the city at night were given luminous covers

Ø All constructions and buildings are inspected precisely during excavation; thus, the rate of injuries due to construction-destruction has become zero in Andisheh during recent years.

### **Violence prevention**

- Ø in order to aware the citizens and empower them, numerous festivals were held including wedding day festivals, mother's day, Haft Seen , handcrafts, different celebrations for children, and children safety
- Ø holding training courses concerning "preventing social hazards" for parents of high school students
- Ø holding training courses for parents and families who were at risk of social hazards
- Ø providing free psychological consultation at secretariat with regard to preventing domestic violence
- Ø Holding various life skill training courses for women
- Ø Holding children law Training courses for the parents of elementary and guidance school students
- Ø leaflets concerning social hazards prevention were printed and distributed to
- Ø holding training courses for suicide prevention

### **Disaster preparedness and response**

- Ø Holding monthly meetings with the authorities of the disaster relief institutions and offices
- Ø allocating the 17 acres park of the 3rd phase to be used as "emergency park" at the time of natural disasters; in addition, 500 alcoves were constructed in the park.
- Ø Establishment of the crisis management headquarter
- Ø Executing national regulations for construction to reinforce under construction buildings
- Ø Various earthquake and natural disasters preparedness maneuvers
- Ø Training the Families and the students for natural disasters preparedness
- Ø Designing and distribution of Leaflets and brochures among the families

**2.2 Describe the work with genders, all ages and all environments and situations. Describe all activities like falls prevention and how the work is done**

## 0-14 years old group

Numerous programs are designed for this age group according to their high rate of accidents specially falling from height, burn, and child abuse. Kindergartens, schools and recreational centers are the main sites of executing these preventing measures.

With respect to the children's vulnerability and their related injuries including falling off from buildings roofs, burns, sexual abuse, physical and emotional violence against children, in addition to injuries due to unsafe playgrounds, and two workgroups were concerned with the children's safety; children and playground safety workgroup and high-risk behavior prevention workgroup.

Ø In children and playground safety workgroup a checklist with 20 topics was designed and all playgrounds of Andisheh City were visited and inspected to conform the checklist. All metal playthings were removed from playgrounds and their floor was replaced by polyethylene materials. All playground materials were checked and international standards were considered at the time of buying new playthings. Playgrounds near the streets were closed and transferred to the local parks with appropriate distance from streets.

Ø In high-risk behavior prevention workgroup, the members of the city NGO started determination of family with vulnerable children including those with addicted parents, divorce children, and those with no or improper warden. These families attended psychology and psychiatry sessions at the municipality amphitheater since October 2010 and their children were followed continuously.

The safety measures training was initiated in schools and kindergartens and preparedness against disasters, fire, suffocation, and etc. was introduced to all the children.

Ø In the year 2010, the universal children's day was celebrated in Hejab complex with the platitude of "the child at the heart of the millennium development, working for the just safety promotion" and attendance of the UNICEF president in Iran and more than 2000 children.

Ø With the coordination of welfare and rehabilitation organization, all the kindergartens in the city were inspected carefully for safety and a one month ultimatum was given to those with defect to conform with the safety standards; then, they were reevaluated and for those with uncorrected flaws, a written notification and another two-week respite was given formally.

Ø The conditions of taxi drivers responsible for students' commutation was evaluated; beside getting organized by Taxi organization, they were introduced to the regulations of transferring students. It resulted in decreasing the rate of injuries associated with students' commutation.

Ø Construction of the standard pleasure park of Andisheh City in a 70,000 m<sup>2</sup> area is planned; it will become the first safe pleasure park in Iran which can be visited by the representatives of other countries to simulate the safety measures; the construction will be finished by the end of 2012.

Ø Accelerating the process of constructing the "child house and nurturing the creativity" in a 2615m<sup>2</sup> area at 4<sup>th</sup> phase is another object of this workgroup; with the substructure of 1650m<sup>2</sup>, library, playground, and training room, this complex is designed in association of the children's needs.

Ø Introducing the School mayor is another activity of the workgroup. After nomination of students and holding an election, the school mayor has to supervise the health, safe traffic, and preparedness for daily adverse events.

Ø Another workgroup's activity is School police and police assistant and distributing respective items such as flags, whistle, and vest among the selected children.

Determination of high-risk areas that surround the schools was implemented axial lineation performed and caution signs were installed.

#### 15 -24 years old group

With the collaboration of NGOs, effective interventions were implied with regard to youth and students safety and social hazards

- Ø Gathering information with regard to this age group injuries and damages are prioritized
- Ø Categorizing and prioritization of injuries
- Ø Holding "the youngster and social hazards" Conferences
- Ø Holding exhibition of posters concerning social hazards in the city schools
- Ø Monthly, numerous exhibitions and festivals with different titles and for different occasions are organized by NGOs collaboration to empower citizens, especially youngsters, against social hazards; during these events, the objectives of the safe community is introduced to the citizens and authorities. Some of these goals are:
  - Ø Dress and safety exhibition focusing on different Iranian costumes
  - Ø Holding art, cultural, and scientific training sources in municipality cultural center for leisure time
  - Ø Bestowing "no tobacco stores" logo to the store owners who express their interest after becoming oriented to the program of not selling cigarettes and tobacco; the peculiar signboards were installed in the store where people can easily notice.
  - Ø Wearing helmet by motorcyclists was meticulously controlled
  - Ø In order to employ the youngsters in safe and free environments and protect them from of social hazards, construction of three cultural centers and libraries was considered in th municipality plans. The public library and Imam Ali cultural center are inaugurated in 3<sup>rd</sup> phase of city and construction of two libraries one in an area of 500m<sup>2</sup> and substructure of 650m<sup>2</sup> and the other in an area of 4000m<sup>2</sup> with the substructure of 1000m<sup>2</sup> both in two stories in 2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> phases, respectively, are in the way to accomplish.
  - Ø Holding sexual education courses for youngsters

#### 25 -64 years old group

Ø With regard to injuries happening at homes, a need for female firefighters was felt; therefore, female firefighters were trained.

- Ø Holding marriage anniversary ceremony with the title of "marriage and family establishment, reducing social hazards"
- Ø Holding Haft Seen festival; in this year, the 120m tablecloth of the Andisheh safe community had caught the eyes.
- Ø Leaflets and brochures containing home safety and social hazards remarks were distributed among the citizens
- Ø Holding healthy food festival
- Ø Another successful interaction of this workgroup is educating safety measures to housewives; home hazards and safety measures to prevent them were taught to 3000 women.
- Ø With collaboration of health network, free courses of "self-aid" are held.
- Ø On international midwife day, the midwives of the city, workers in health network, and those interested in health were praised.

More than 64 years old

With respect to the condition of old and disabled citizens, safety of environments according to their needs was considered as a priority. No old people's home or rehabilitation center exists in Andisheh city; therefore, all of these citizens are transferred to the nearest sanitarium, namely Qods sanitarium. Accordingly, the secretariat has formulated a supporting program for those inhabit this sanitarium.

Ø Every month, interested women and the principle members of the steering committee visit the sanitarium and deliver the presents prepared by the safe community secretariat; in addition, they get apprised of their needs and take action to compensate the flaws and deficiencies.

Ø A specific elevator to the disables and old citizens is installed in the municipality building; moreover, ramps with the width appropriate for wheelchair passage were designed and installed in pedestrian bridges of the city.

Ø Disabled day ceremony was hold by attendance of disables representatives and performance of disable artists.

Ø To facilitate disables transportation, mobile ramps were installed in buses of the city; these ramps are used when disables want to get in or out of bus.

Ø Mechanized pedestrian bridges were constructed to facilitate passage of this age group across the streets

Ø Training families who have an old member with regard to treatment, safety, and diseases of this age group

#### **Addicts**

With collaboration of Tehran safe community, establishment of a branch of "Rebirth" NGO for addiction prevention and quitting narcotics abuse in the city was set into the safe community agenda

- Holding the meetings of Addiction prevention workgroups by attendance of NA society members
- Collaboration with NA society non-profit center and providing a place for holding their sessions and holding meetings for its members was among this workgroup activities; at present, 180addicts are under treatment at this center.
- Holding training courses entitled "addiction among youngsters"
- Executing "Non- tobacco store" program

#### **Disabled citizens**

- Designing and installation of ramps with the width appropriate for wheelchair passage in pedestrian bridges construction and installation of mechanized pedestrian bridges to facilitate passage of elderly and disabled citizens across the streets
- Leveling the sidewalks to facilitate the disabled citizens' passage and determining a way for visually handicapped citizens' passage
- Installing a specific elevator to the disables and old citizens in the municipality building
- Installing mobile ramps in buses of the city to facilitate disables transportation
- Holding ceremony of "Disable days" with participation of active NGOs

## Adults

- Every month, interested women and the principle members of the steering committee visit the sanitarium and deliver the presents prepared by the safe community secretariat; in addition, they get apprised of their needs and take action to compensate the flaws and deficiencies.
- Leveling the sidewalks to prevent elderly citizens fall-off
- Training families who have an old member with regard to treatment, safety, and diseases of this age group
- Designing and installing mobile ramps in buses of the city to facilitate elderly citizens transportation
- Organizing elderly walking convention to celebrate “the international day of older persons”
- Holding ceremony and celebration for elderly citizens

High risk environments are construction sites, streets near the school and kindergarten, factories

High risk environments are identified by fire station and emergency center because they receive some report of injured people in these places.

According to the statistic of fire station and emergency center about numbers of inured or death people in high risk environment safe community of Andisheh city appoints different workgroups with members of related organization in order to develop a strategy for sustained program.

**4.1 Describe the evidence-based strategies/programs that have been implemented for different age-groups and environments.**

Safe community secretariat has utilized available resources published by world health organization and has applied their guidelines with attention to native culture and current situation in Andisheh city, for instance, with reading the book “ violence prevention the evidence”.

For prevention traffic accidents on the roads, guidelines of the book “advocating for road safety and road traffic injury victims” has been included on the agenda of traffic and roads network accidents workgroup.

Finally guidelines of the book “World report on child injury prevention” , is on the agenda of children and playground safety workgroup

**4.2 Has any contacts been established with ASCSCs, WHO CCCSP, other scientific institutions, or knowledgeable organizations about the development and/or implementation of evidence-based strategies? Which ones? What has been the extent of their counsel?**

Yes, safe community of Andisheh city has contact by Tehran safe community, Islamic Azad university of Andisheh city, Shahid Beheshti university of Tehran and Iran University of medical sciences.

### 5.1 What local data is used to determine the injury prevention strategies?

**For example, registering injuries can be done at hospitals, health centers, dentists, schools, care of the elderly organizations and the local police.**

**Household surveys can also be used for collection of data about injuries and risk environments and risk situations.**

**Which methods are used in the community?**

Data registration system is based on collected forms from Fire station, Emergency center, Traffic, Hospitals and Members of NGOs. These data has been collected monthly and then they record on a data base, Similar items are omitted; finally, secretariat uses the collected information for decision making and evaluation of safety programs. It is worth mentioning that all pictures photos and evidences are documented

### 5.2 Describe how data are presented in order to promote safety and prevent injuries in the community.

Collected data shows that which age groups are expose to hazard more than others or which environments are high risk for people. So it helps policy makers to making a sustainable programs for injury prevention and safety promotion.

### 5.3 Describe how the community documents and uses knowledge about causes of injuries, groups at risk and risky environments. How does the community document progress over time?

Analyzing data collected from different organizations shows that, all organizations have their different approaches for recording information. This data shows number of death and injured people in 2010 according to the age among totally 70 people in Andisheh city.

Because of different methods were used for information collection; safe community policymaking council of Tehran designed an integrated accident recording system, also this system is used in Andisheh city from the beginning of 2012.

The system is based on cooperation of public organizations and nongovernmental organization involved in the accidents; with following objectives:

- Reduction and omission wrong information from report of organization
- Easy access to the information
- Investigating factors which cause the accidents and incidents
- Determining accidents/incidents codes
- Designing implementing method in order to gather information, accidents/incidents
- Designing forms in order to document accidents/incidents
- Detecting and evaluating activities
- Standardizing information gathering method



Safe community steering committee of Andisheh city evaluates its programs regard to Indicators for International safe communities; so for documentation, monitoring and evaluation a specialized team is appointed by safe community secretariat of Tehran city. The appointed team is appointed to monitor, evaluate and document performed actions; safe community is evaluated through a checklist in different stages, also field survey, minutes and questionnaires are utilized as evaluation tools of the safe community. All actions are monitored every six months; the corrective action is taken place.

### 6.2 Describe how the results from the program evaluations are used

Result from the program shows that which hazard has a high priority for injury prevention and safety promotion this hazard is on the agenda of safe community of Andisheh city.

### 6.3 Describe the changes in pattern of injuries, attitudes, behavior and knowledge of the risks for injuries as a result of the programs.

The mortality rate due to CO had a decrease of 80% in the year 2010 in contrast to previous year. Following diagram shows the changes of injuries due to different accidents in 2010 and 2011



## Section I Indicator 7

### **7.1 Describe how the community has joined in and collaborates in national and international safe community networks.**

After 16<sup>th</sup> international conference on safety community, and the first national conference in Tehran, we were motivated to become a member of the International Safe Community Network. Accordingly, Islamic councils of the city, deputies, and managing directors of municipality organization met to define primary principles and designation procedure. Then, a expense expectation was submitted to Islamic council of Andisheh City; after the approval by the members the expenses expectation was submitted to Shahryar county and Tehran province. The bill was approved based on majority of votes. The idea of designation of Andisheh city as a member of the International Safe Community Network was proposed to the Safe Community Policy Making Council in Tehran on March 2010 and it was approved by Tehran secretariat while Municipality of Tehran undertook supporting of the safe community of Andisheh City. District 10 of Tehran was introduced as supporter of Andisheh city
