Section A

Community Overview

A.1 Briefly describe the community and its historical development :

Municipality of district 11 is limited to district 6 in north, districts 10 and 17 in west, district 16 in south and district 12 in East. The northern zone of the region has administrative and residential structure, the central zone is business, trading, administrative and residential district and the southern zone has residential and warehousing application. The limits of the zone are: Enghelab and Azadi street in north, Vahdat Eslami and Hafez in east, Railway Square (Raahahan Sq.) and Shoush in south and Shahid Navab Safavi in west.

There are 45 cultural, social and sports complexes in the region under municipality coverage, giving it a special place among the 22 zones of Tehran.

There are five fire departments in the region, making it one of the safe parts in fire fighting scope and in any events, the fire department is in spot in less than 5 minutes.

Due to the centrality of grand Bazaar of Tehran adjacent to this district, there are largest numbers of bikers and economic trips in district 1`2 of Tehran that causes several traffic risks in the district.

A.2 Describe the strategy, ambitions, objectives and work in the community in regard to safety. It must be a higher level of safety than average for a community in the country or region.

Safe community Steering committee of District 11 has decided to prevent intentional and unintentional injuries, and is required to execute effective projects by involving public and private organizations and change the district to a safe place for living, education, working, and leisure activities; accordingly, the following objectives are accomplished:

1. Increasing the Citizens participation in planning & execution of safe community projects .
2. Calling regional managers attention to the safety promotion and injury prevention
3. Improving inter-sector coordination and collaboration in order to involve them in the environmental safety promotion
4. To prevent injuries due to interpersonal violence in District 11
5. To develop an injuries registration system in District 11

A.3 How are the mayor (or similar function of the? community) and the executive committee involved? Who is chairing the cross-sector group

Mr.Dr.Massod kefayat mand is the mayor and chairman of the safe community steering committee at District 11.

A.4 Describe the injury risk-panorama in the community.

According to the statistical reviews in previous years and type and location of the damages , the steering committee held meetings; finally, four following workgroups were appointed to formally initiate concerning activities:

- 1) Work team of the safe traffic.(motor cycler)
- 2) Workgroup of the children and woman safety
- 3) Workgroup of safe work place(job)

Section B

Structure of the community .

B.1 Describe the demographic structure of the community

The area of this district is 12.6 square kilometers and its population is around 300 thousand people with more than two million people as floating population. This region is almost in the central part of Tehran. According to the initial results of 2006 census on people and houses, the population of this region is 275,595 people, 141466 of them are male and 131429 are female. In addition, there are 84849 families in the region. The main streets are Hafez, Vahdat Eslami, Kargar, Vali Asr, Imam Khomeini, Jomhouri, Ghazvin, Helal Ahmar and Molavi. The squares are Monirieh, Pasteur, Horr, Ghazvin, Razi, Behdari, Raahahan and Robot Karim.

Based on the last census data, the areas of parks in the region is 50 hectares in 25 parks. Razi Park in zone 4 is one of the largest recreation complexes of Tehran with recreations activities such as boats, fishing yards...

B.2 Describe the SC/IP at present and the plans for the future.

All manager and expert person in safety subject have planning for prompting safety in District 11 with :

work groups, representative from governmental and nongovernmental organizations .

Most of decisions for injury prevention are taken by the regional government

The strategic programs of Programs of safe work place workplace: Training to make safe work for people & users.

The mayor of District 11 is responsible for the management of SP/IP programs .
