The programme covers the following safety promotion activities:

For the age group

Children 0-14 years:

- ◆ Little safety member finding out hidden school dangers
- ◆ Student bicycle riding safety
- ◆ Prevention of the school stairs crowd
- ◆ Summer safety knowledge education and raising awareness

Youth 15-24 years:

- ◆ “Returning Program” of Youth Safety
- ◆ AIDS Prevention Campaign
- ◆ “Green Apple” Anti-drug Program
- ◆ Youth Sailing Program---- “Aid in employment of youth” projects

Adults 25-64 years:

- ◆ Improve Fire Safety in Old Residential Building
- ◆ Intensify Propaganda and Popularization of Knowledge of Gas Safety
- ◆ Actively Conduct Discouraging Drunken Driving Publicity Campaign
- ◆ Conduct safety training for immigrant workers

Elderly 65+ years

- ◆ Psychological consultant : project of “Pleasing senior citizen”
- ◆ “Aid in three aspects”: aid in bathing, aid in maintaining cleanliness , aid in medicine
- ◆ Form Caring-pair: volunteers are mobilized to form caring pairs with old people
- ◆ Carefree Old Age program: provide senior citizen with the accident insurance
- ◆ First-aid Treatment: install emergency beeper to enable them call for help

At the following environments:

1. Home safety

- ◆ Improve Fire Safety in Old Residential Building
- ◆ Build self-management teams of residents’ health
- ◆ Spread and learn the general knowledge of how to use fire, electricity, gas. Training the household safety knowledge

- ◆ Strengthened different seasonal safety inspection in the residential areas
- ◆ Emergency Treatment of injury and family first-aid training

2. Traffic Safety

- ◆ Achieve Intervention-free Passage in Huaihai Road and Huangpi Road
- ◆ Carry Out Safety Training on Bicycle Riding For Secondary School Students
- ◆ Expand Traffic Safety Publicity Channels
- ◆ Publicize Knowledge of Traffic Safety

3. Occupational Safety

- ◆ Regularly visit and inspect units, construction sites, and high-risk places within the district to eliminate safety threats timely.
- ◆ Strengthen training for migrant worker and special working personnel
- ◆ Strengthen routine supervision
- ◆ Establish hierarchical supervision system
- ◆ Establish production safety model with participation of all concerned parties

4. School Safety

- ◆ Combination of “indirection experience → direct experience → self-reflection experience → digest of experience”
- ◆ Popularization & training mode of “schools → teachers → students → parents”
- ◆ Carry out inquiry for “safety signs around me” and recognize school safety signs
- ◆ Strengthen experience activities: rectification suggestions and supervise results

5. Sports Safety

- ◆ Establish Fitness Courts Checking System
- ◆ Manage Body Exercises Places by Designated Personnel Adopting Local Management
- ◆ Strengthen Training on Management Personnel and Maintenance Workers
- ◆ Strengthen Maintenance and Replacement Works of Body Exercises Facilities

6. Leisure Safety

- Enrich Spiritual and Cultural Life of the Elders
- ◆ Improve popularization of Scientific Body Exercises Knowledge

◆Carried out “five grasps of every one” activity: everyone knows blood pressure, rescue skills, body exercises, blood donation without pay, healthy habits

◆Concern about life needs and safety ensure services of migrant workers

Surveillance of injuries: Disease Control Center , Luwan Branch of Ruijin Hospital , Community Health Center, Community health station and neighborhood committees within the region

Numbers per year: 2 times per year
