Robert Ekman B.Sc., M.P.H., Ph.D., is an Associate Professor at Department of Public Health Sciences at Karolinska Institutet, Stockholm, Sweden.

His daily work is related to the National Centre for Learning from Incidents and Accidents (NCO) at the Swedish Rescue Services Agency. He has been active in public health and community safety for more than 25 years. His research concerns injury surveillance, methods for intervention and evaluation, analysis of community safety promotion programmes, traffic safety, child safety and safety among the elderly.

He has organised international and national conferences, national seminars on community safety and Master courses on injury prevention. He was a local health planning officer during the 1980s in Lidköping, Sweden - the worlds first designated international Safe Community 1989.
